With this assignment we will sequence the images to make your work stronger when showing to clients, galleries, and peers.

Yes, even if you choose not to sequence you have sequenced. Sequencing can change the meaning of images. What is placed side by side will affect how we interpret the next or the last image.

We will look at color, shape, content of the images while placing the images. This will help the viewer move from one image to the next in a logical way. We can tell a story or flow from one image to the next without being distracted from the whole
