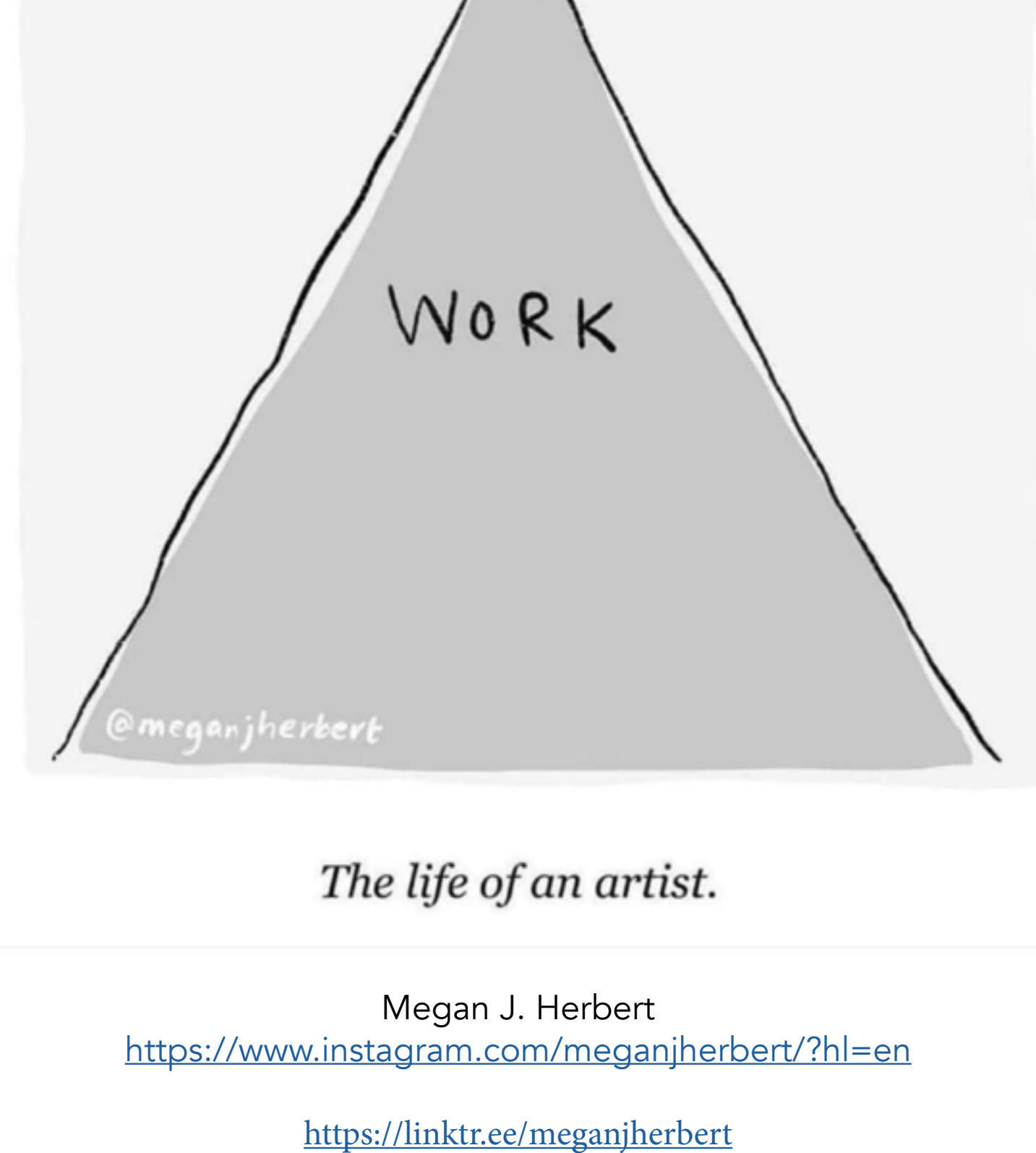

The Crouched Ones, 1934

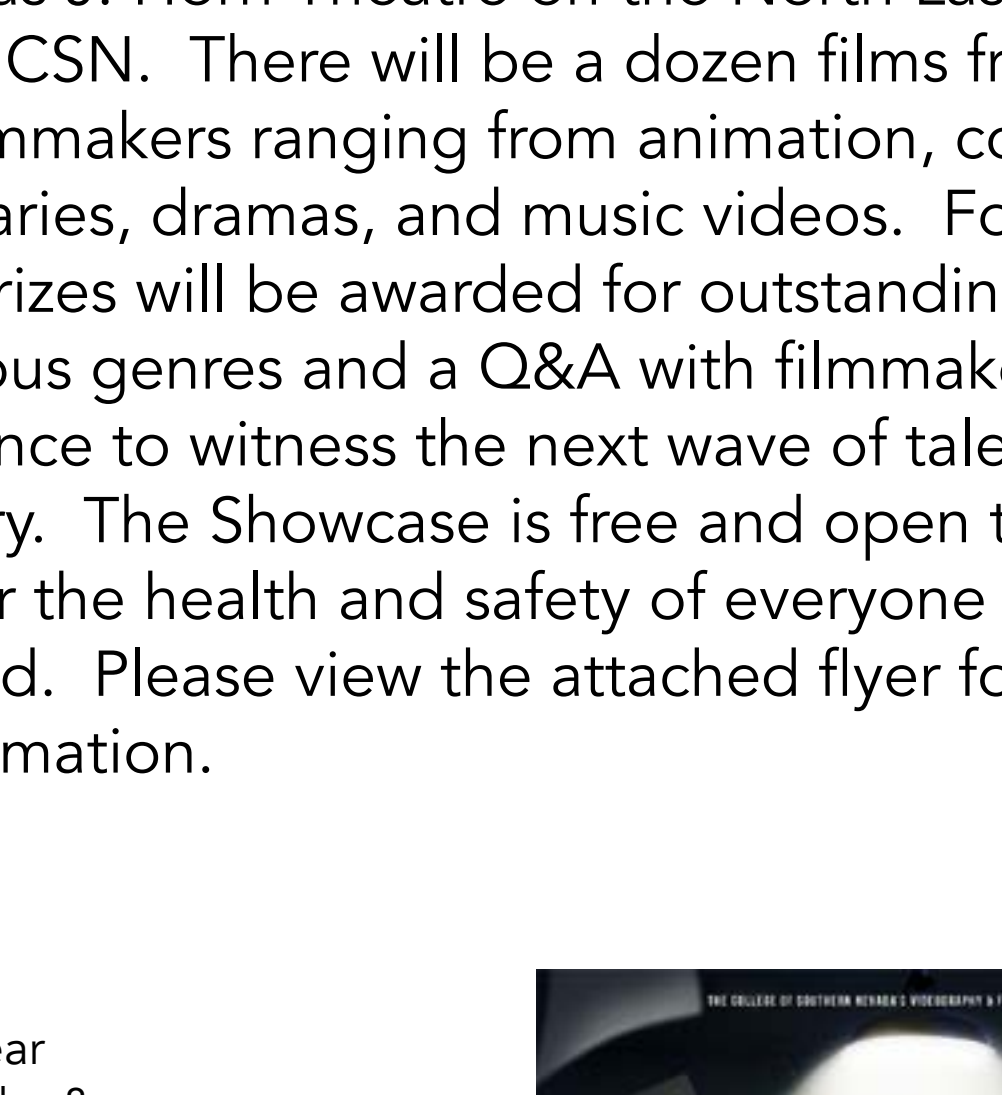


Burial at Metepec, 1932

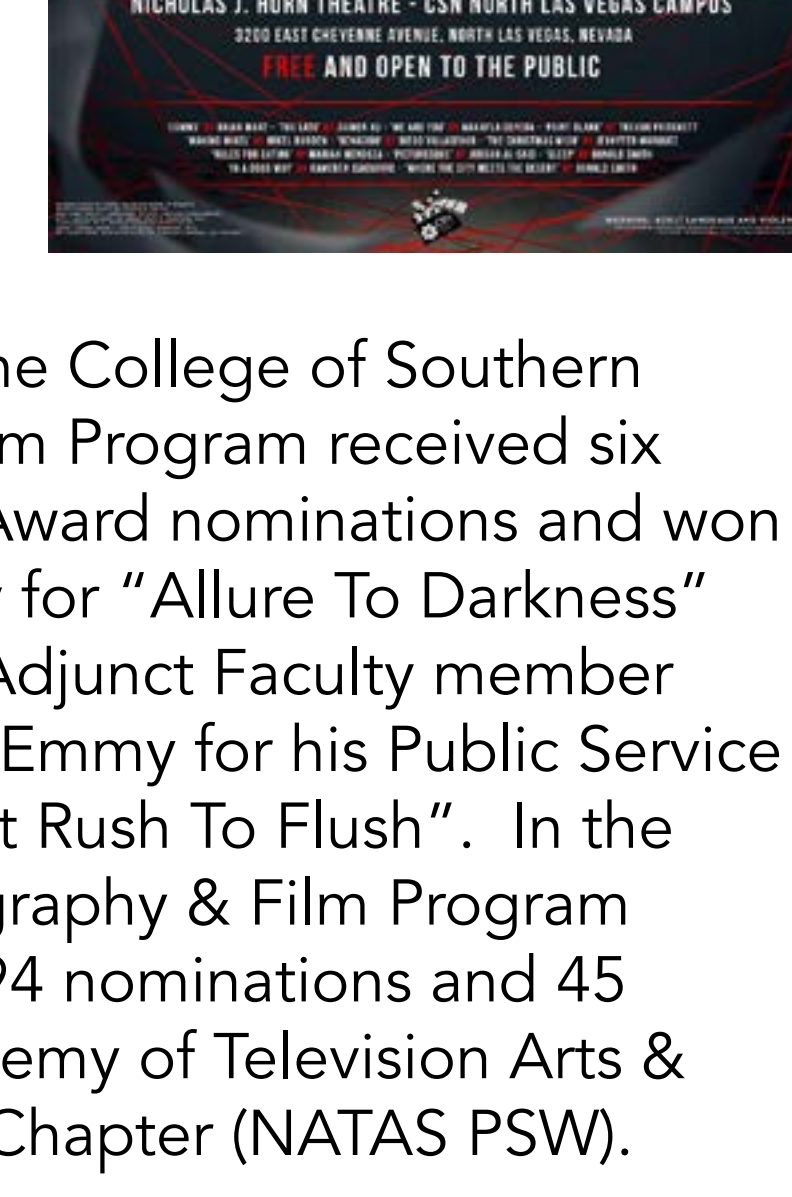

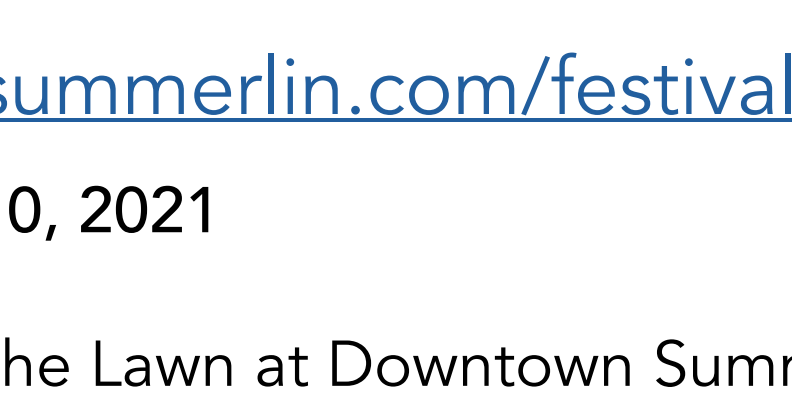

There will be a dozen films from our student filmmakers ranging from animation, comedies, documentaries, dramas, and music videos. Following the films prizes will be awarded for outstanding work in the various genres and a Q&A with filmmakers is an experience to witness the next wave of talent in this industry. Every year Videography & Film works with the Graphics Program and has one of their classes compete among the students to create the annual Showcase poster. This winning mystery noir poster was created by Freddy Calva and captures the spirit of the times.

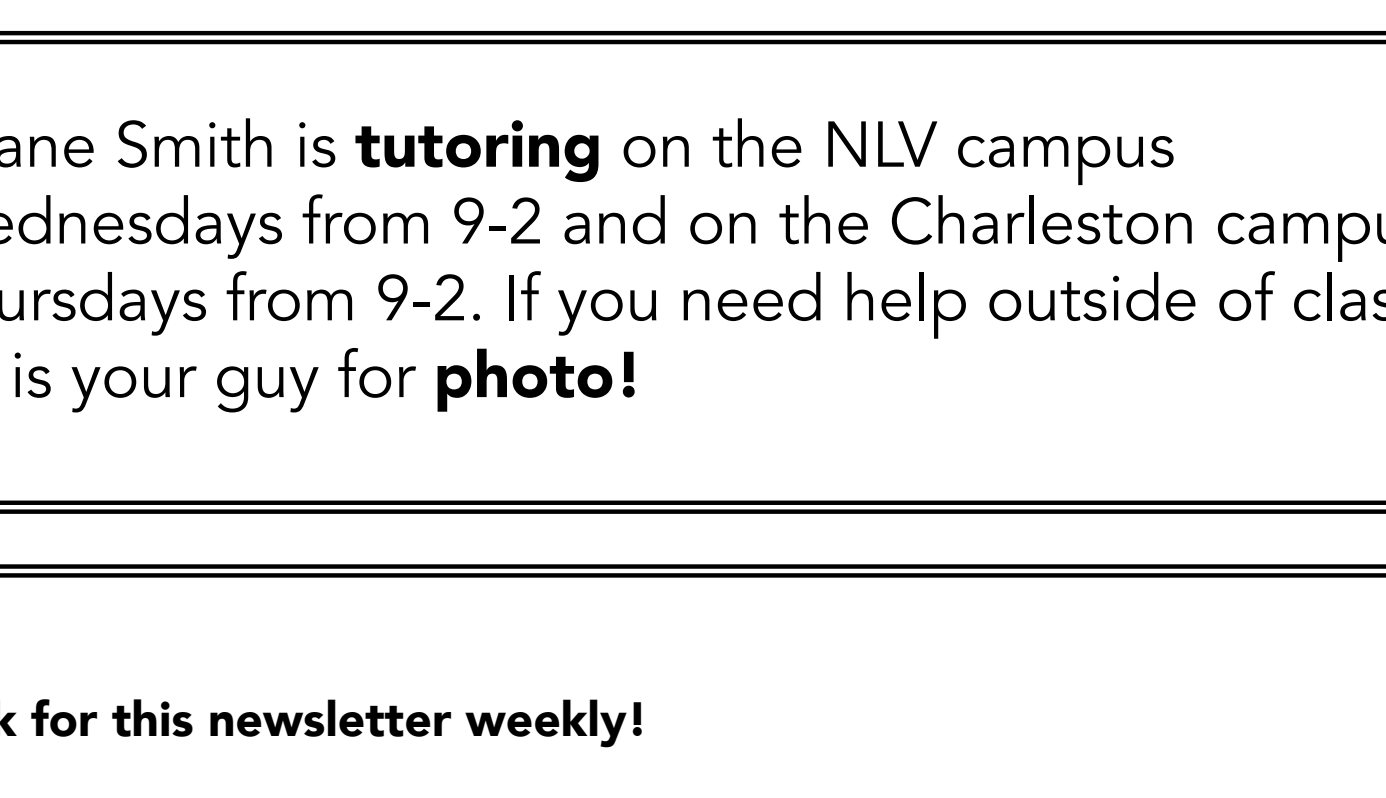
